

Discharge Instructions- Knee Arthroscopy

After Your Surgery:

- 1. Use your crutches when walking until otherwise instructed
- 2. Wear your brace at all times remove only as instructed, do not change the settings
- 3. Keep your leg elevated for the next 2-3 days
- 4. Use ice/cold therapy as needed for swelling and pain relief
- 5. Do not drive a car until cleared by your surgeon

Activity:

- 1. Continue your home exercise program as instructed by physical therapy
- 2. Your surgeon will let you know when to begin outpatient therapy

Wound Care:

- 1. Change dressing daily and place TED stocking on your surgical leg until follow-up
- 2. Some bloody drainage on dressing is normal

If Taking Oral Pain Medications:

- 1. Follow instructions as printed on prescription
- 2. When your pain is mild you may use medication such as Tylenol or Ibuprofen
- 3. Do not drink alcohol while taking pain medication
- 4. Pain medications can cause constipation

Call Your Surgeon For:

- 1. Temperature above 101 degrees and/or chills present for more than 2 days
- 2. Pain not relieved by oral pain medication
- 3. Swelling ,coldness, paleness, blue coloring, numbness or tingling in operative foot
- 4. Any sign of incisional infection
